The platform uses Axon's proprietary tank database to collect and validate facility and tank information, reducing manual re-keying, claims issues arising from incorrect tank data, and broker E&O exposure.

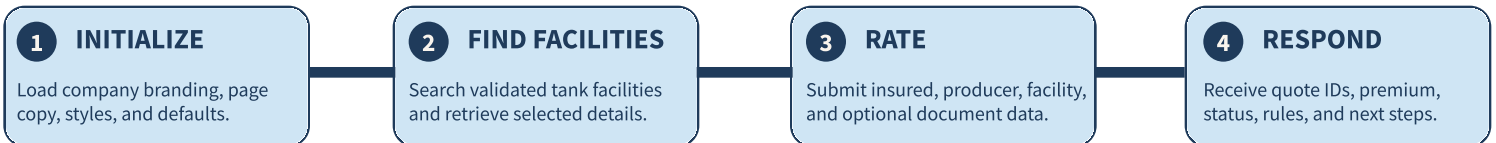

REQUEST AND RESPONSE SHAPE

REQUEST

core submission data
producer contact details, insured details, selected facility IDs, and a small set of facility or risk attributes.

optional support files
supporting documents may be attached when available, but they are not required for the automated quote path.

RECEIVE

quote identifiers
quote references for downstream workflow and status tracking.

quote outcome
premium, response status, response title, response message, and validation or referral messaging.
